SUMMARY:

School District Nurse substitute position available up to 7 hours/day during the school year.

Essential Functions: The school nurse provides health care services to students by performing the following duties.

- Provides first-aid and maintains health records of students and responds to emergency services within school RN scope of responsibilities.
- Follows nursing tasks as directed by District Registered Nurse (RN), including but not limited to, medication administration, insulin administration, and medical procedures
- Assists in programs for care of children with disabilities and other health conditions.
- Other duties as necessary/assigned.
