Highland School District #203 is presently accepting applications for substitute teachers at the elementary, middle school and high school levels.

- Emergency substitutes will be considered, must have a valid certificate for use in Highland.

SALARY & BENEFITS: Compensation for the 2024-2025 school year: \$200/day, \$100.00/half-day (PreK-6th), \$26.66/hour-partial day (7-12). Long-term teaching subs get bumped to appropriate equivalent pay on official scale but may not miss a day for any reason. Missing a day resets the count to zero. Increase in pay does not pertain to Emergency certified subs as they are not fully qualified.
