Candidate Orientation

Candidates for appointment or election to the board will be encouraged to attend public meetings of the board. Public information about the school system will be available to them as they might request.

Additionally, the superintendent will interact impartially with all candidates in providing them with information about school governance, board operations and school programs. Information to board candidates may include;

- A. Notifying the candidate of open meetings of the board, accompanied with an agenda;
- B. Meeting with the candidate to provide background information on the school system and board service;
- C. Providing each candidate with access to publications of the district, materials from the Washington State School Directors' Association, the official minutes of board meetings and the district policy manual;
- D. Reviewing the district budget and related fiscal documents; and
- E. Providing each candidate with information regarding the Public Disclosure Act.
